

Now The Walk is even better connected.

You may have heard just how well connected The Walk is to established parks, schools, shopping and leisure facilities. Well now it's even better connected, thanks to improved transport connections on the Perth-to-Mandurah railway.

The recent opening of Cockburn Central train station means The Walk is now just a 16-minute train journey to central Perth – and a mere 31 minutes to Mandurah.

Free parking is available at Cockburn Central train station which is less than 4 minutes' drive from The Walk. However, to avoid parking hassles (especially during the peak hours) it's best to take advantage of Transperth's regular connecting bus service.
